Finnegans Irish Amber is brewed with potatoes and three varieties of imported two-row malts. The beer is pale amber in color but light in body. A gentle hop bitterness compliments its complex malt character.

**Food Pairings:** Meat (Pork, Poultry)

**Glassware:** Pint Glass (or Becker, Nonic, Tumbler), Mug (or Seidel, Stein)

**Storage Temp @:** 35-40°F (Not recommended for extended cellaring)

**Serving Temp @:** 40-45°F
